CHANGES – EXPECTED AND UNEXPECTED

Abatement work in the 1953 building (east end) to remove asbestos has been ongoing and is expected to be completed this week. This work area will remain off limits for any church use. Some of this work resulted in the unexpected loss of the hot water supply to the building. Restoration of some of the hot water services is being undertaken over the next few weeks. Additional abatement work will occur in the lower level at a time to be determined in the New Year.

The driveway on the east end of the church was closed while the abatement work commenced but has now been re-opened. Please note that it will be “permanently” closed during construction.

CONTRACT AND APPROVALS

The ReKindle Project Management Team is still hard at work finalizing our contract with TRP Construction. They do expect to receive the Site Plan Approval from the City of Burlington shortly. The building permit process continues and as soon as timing expectations are available they will be communicated

DEMOLITION

Demolition will start following the receipt of the building permit. The best case at this time looks like middle to end of December but it is more likely to be in the New Year.
